



Weekly 2-meter Net Script

1858 hrs. We will be starting the WestVARS net in 2 minutes. If anyone needs to use this repeater, please do so now. This is **(CALL SIGN)**.

1900 hrs. This is **(CALL SIGN)** for the WestVARS net. This net meets each Wednesday at 1900 hours eastern standard time on the Whiskey Victor 4 Alpha Romeo Sierra FM repeater. My name is **(NAME)** I'm located in the **(CITY/TOWN)**, which is in the County of Volusia here in Florida. I will be your net control for this session.

The Whiskey Victor 4 Alpha Romeo Sierra FM repeater at 147.315 with a PL tone of 103.5, is linked to the internet via ECHOLINK Node 887321 and Allstar Node 59840.

Please remember that this repeater takes about ½ second for the PL tone to open the squelch.

This is a directed net. Please follow Net control instructions.

When checking in, please give your call sign slowly and phonetically twice, followed by your name and location. I will acknowledge after all stations from your area have checked in. Please remain on frequency until released by net control. If for any reason you need to leave during the session, please inform net control that you are securing your station.

For those with 10-meter, 6-meter and/or 70-centimeter DMR capability, we conduct three additional nets. The DMR net meets this evening at 2030 hours on the KN4EHC repeater: 442.225 MHz +5 MHz Brand Meister talk group 311679, Timeslot 1, Color Code 1.

On Thursdays the 10-meter net starts at 1900 hours on frequency 28.315 MHz Simplex and the 6-meter net starts immediately after on 52.04 MHz FM Simplex.

Are there any net announcements or bulletins? (Net control to announce next monthly meeting.)

I have the following announcement for this week. Our regular monthly meetings are held at 1900 hours on the second Monday monthly. Please visit WestVARS.org for further details. Anyone interested in amateur radio is cordially invited.

Are there any other announcements or bulletins please come now. (Pause for all stations with announcements or bulletins. Record each station's call sign, name, have them make the announcements now.

Do we have any stations short of time? (Pause for all short of time stations.

Do we have any mobile stations? (Pause for all mobile stations)

This is (CALL SIGN) for the WestVARS net control this evening. I will now take MEMBERSHIP check- ins for the Net BY AREA... Record each station's call sign, name, and location.

Wait for all stations for the area to check-in, then confirm each check-in for that area.

Starting with Echolink MEMBERSHIP stations. Are there any Echolink stations please come now.

Next, the Northern area membership for Volusia County only... the first area, our largest area, DeLand, also to include Lake Helen, operators come now.

(Ask for any additional check-ins or corrections before moving on to the next area.)

Continuing with the Northwest membership areas of Volusia County only... these areas include Glenwood, DeLeon Springs, and Pierson... come now.

(Ask for any additional check-ins or corrections before moving on to the next area.)

Next, the Southwest membership areas of Volusia County only... these areas include DeBary, Enterprise, Orange City, Deltona and Osteen.

(Ask for any additional check-ins or corrections before moving on to the next area.)

I will now take station check-ins from outside the WestVARS.org membership.

(Record each station's call sign, name, and location.)

(Now ask for any additional announcements.)

All stations checked-in to the net are invited and encouraged to participate in the discussion and comments. **(Call all checked-in stations in the order they are checked in and ask for their input.)**

I will now start with the comments: **(Calling the stations that checked-in to participate)**

This is **(CALL SIGN)**, WestVARS® net control. If you have any additional comments, suggestions or concerns that are related to Ham Radio and/or our club. For information on joining, please visit the WestVARS.org. **(Pause for response)**

Is there anything we can do for anyone on the frequency? If so, please give your call sign now. **(Pause for response)**
