



WESTVARS® 2- Meter Net Script

18:58 hrs. We will be starting the West VARS 2m net in 2 minutes. If anyone needs to use this repeater, please do so now. This is *(Your call sign)*.

19:00 hrs. This is *(Your call sign)* for the WestVARS 2m net. I will be your net control for this session. My name is *(Your Name)* I'm located in *(Your City)* Volusia County, Fl. This net meets each Wednesday at 7pm local time on the WV4ARS VHF FM repeater The 2m net is linked to the internet via ECHOLINK Node 187321 and Allstar Node 598401. West VARS also conducts three (3) other nets DMR, 10m and 6m. For details go to the WestVARS website at WESTVARS.org

A reminder when keying your microphone please wait for ½ second before you speak. This will prevent your first syllables from being cut-off.

All licensed radio amateurs are invited to check in to the net. This is a directed net. Please follow Net control instructions.

When checking in, please give your call sign slowly, then repeat your call-sign phonetically, followed by your name and location. I will acknowledge your check in after all stations from your area have checked in.

Before I start the check in, do I have a backup to record the check ins?

Do I have a traffic rep to take formal written traffic? **(traffic Rep someone that can take NTS Traffic)**

At this time is there any EMERGENCY, Priority, or Routine traffic for the net?

Unless it is an emergency or priority traffic, all traffic will be directed to the Volusia County Traffic net, which meets on the 147.150 with CTCSS Tone 127.3 NTS repeater daily at 18:30 hour's local time.

I have the following net announcements for this week. **(Net control to announce next monthly meeting and club events).**

The WestVARS club meetings are held on the second Monday of every month at 7pm, the location can be found on the WestVARS website WestVARS.org. Our next meeting will be ***(month and date)***. Anyone interested in amateur radio is cordially invited.

Are there any other announcements or bulletins please come now.

(Pause for all stations with announcements or bulletins. Record each station's call sign, name, have them make the announcements now.

Do we have any stations short of time? *(Pause for all short of time stations).*

Do we have any mobile stations? *(Pause for all mobile stations).*

This is *(Your call sign)* WestVARS net control. I will now take check- ins. Starting with members only.

Echolink stations please come now. *Record each station's call sign, name, and location*

Next, calling on West Central Volusia County: Deland, Lake Helen

Next, calling the Northwest area of Volusia County: Glenwood, Pierson, Deleon Springs.

Next, calling the Southwest area of Volusia County: DeBary, Enterprise, Orange City, Osteen and Deltona.

Next, calling stations outside of Volusia County including visitors and late check-ins.

All stations checked-in to the net are invited and encouraged to participate in the discussion and comments.

I will now start with the comments: *(Calling the stations in the order they checked-in.)*
